BY-LAW 12-003

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF WATSON LAKE TO ESTABLISH A RECREATION
ADVISORY COMMITTEE FO THE TOWN OF WATSON LAKE

Whereas Section 191 (1) of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 154 of the Revised Statutes of the Yukon, 2002, and amendments thereto, states that "Council may by Bylaw establish committees, boards and commissions and their function"

Now therefore the Council for the Town of Watson Lake, in open meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:


Short title:


1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Recreation Advisory Committee" bylaw.
2. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "Committee" means the Recreation Advisory Committee
 - (b) "Chair" means the Chair of the Committee
 - (c) "Council" means the Council for the Town of Watson Lake
 - (d) "Municipality" means the Municipality of Watson Lake
3. Mandate/Duties of the Committee.
 - (a) The Committee will be an advisory group to Council and advice and recommendations on the following:
 1. The future direction of Recreation in the municipality, and maximizing the use of present facilities, and
 2. Reviewing applications for annual YTG Lottery grant funding to municipalities
 - (b) The Committee will have a Chair duly selected from the appointed members.
 - (c) The appointed members shall consist of up to six (6) members of the public.
 - (d) A quorum of the Committee will be a majority of members appointed by Council.
 - (e) On any recommendations from the Committee to Council, it would normally be done by consensus.
 - (f) With applications for lottery funds, a majority of members of the Committee, not declaring a potential conflict of interest, will be required for recommending Council approval.
 - (g) Minutes of all meetings of the Committee shall be submitted to Council.
 - (h) As per Section 181 of the Municipal Act, the Mayor is automatically a member of all Committees, Boards and Commissions established by the Municipality.
 - (i) Section 191(e) of the Municipal Act may be utilized at the discretion of Council.
 - (j) Meetings of the Committee will be held as required.
 - (k) An honourarium of \$100.00 per month is provided to those attending meetings.
 - (l) Minutes of all meetings will be submitted to Council for any actions and or approval.
 - (m) This bylaw comes into full force and effect on the final passing thereof.
